CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

A degree in Disaster and Emergency Management opens the door to a wide array of career paths and opportunities that are not limited to the traditional roles of professional practices and positions within the law enforcement field that includes sectors such as international organisations, non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and private corporations. Some career opportunities includes and not limited to:

a. Emergency Management Director: Graduates can assume leadership roles as emergency management directors in government agencies, overseeing the development and implementation of disaster preparedness and response plans, and coordinating emergency operations during crises.

b. Crisis Communication Specialist: Specialising in communication strategies during emergencies, graduates can work for government agencies, corporations, or PR firms, disseminating accurate information to the public, media, and stakeholders.

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c. Disaster Risk Analyst: Conducting risk assessments and vulnerability analyses for governments, NGOs, and consulting firms to identify potential hazards and develop mitigation strategies to minimise the impact of disasters.

d. Community Resilience Coordinator: Working with local communities, nonprofits, and grassroots organisations to build resilience, develop community emergency response plans, and engage in capacity-building initiatives.

e. Environmental Protection Officer: Focusing on environmental aspects of disaster management, graduates can work for environmental agencies, NGOs, or private sector firms, ensuring compliance with environmental regulations and promoting sustainable practices.

f. Humanitarian Aid Worker: Deploying to disaster-affected regions globally, graduates can provide humanitarian assistance, including food, shelter, medical care, and psychosocial support, with international organisations or NGOs.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- ➔ A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) with a minimum Grade C [Grade Point(GP) 2.0] in any TWO subjects; or any equivalent qualification; OR
- ➔ A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Jayyid (good); OR
- ➔ Any qualifications equivalent to Diploma (Level 4, Malaysian Qualifications Framework (MQF)); OR
- ➔ Matriculation/Foundation qualification with a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.0 out of 4.0; or any equivalent qualification; OR
- ➔ Any equivalent qualification recognised by the University Senate;

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS REQUIREMENT:

- ➔ International applicants are required to have a minimum score of IELTS 6.0 or equivalent OR have attained a senior secondary / secondary education from an institution where the medium of instruction is in English.
