ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A Bachelor's Degree (Level 6, Malaysia Qualifications Framework, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 or equivalent. Applicants with a degree from non-relevant fields will be required to pass the pre-requisite requirements set by the university; or
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in the field or related fields or equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 and not meeting CGPA of 2.75, can be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment; or
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in the field or related fields, or equivalent with minimum CGPA of 2.00 and not meeting CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to a minimum of 5 years working experience in the relevant field and rigorous internal assessment; or
- Candidates without a related qualification in the field/s working experience in the relevant fields must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the university and meet the minimum CGPA based on (i) to (iii) above.
- Any equivalent qualification recognised by the University Senate.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS REQUIREMENT:

International applicants are required to have a minimum score of International English Language Tests System (IELTS) 6.0 or equivalent; OR have attained a degree from a university where the medium of instruction is in English.
